

## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

### Lorne Avenue, Hensall

September 12, 2018

The approved 2018 municipal budget included an allowance to address Lorne Avenue and King Street deficiencies and needs this year.

An engineering study commenced Summer, 2018 toward informing a recommended plan of action to address drainage deficiencies in the area of Lorne Avenue and King Street in Hensall. Bluewater Public Works department is planning to complete drainage improvements immediately (Fall, 2018) as a first measure to address drainage deficiencies and in effort to reduce potential for repeat flooding in this area. This work will mesh with a longer term plan to address deficiencies with the drainage outlet and piped system south side of King Street and broader road needs.

This work is scheduled to start on or about Monday, September 17.

Work to be completed this fall, will include:

- A focus on Lorne Avenue in the area of Queen Street and King Street to improve drainage and provide an improved piped outlet in the area of the south end of Lorne Avenue at King Street. This work should alleviate the incidence of surface ponding during significant rain events and provide an improved piped outlet for more frequent storm events.
- Installation of two replacement catchbasins at intersection of Lorne and King Street with a replacement sewer crossing King Street, related roadside regrading and swale construction.

This work is expected to be completed by mid to end of October.

Residents should expect some delay and periods of traffic disruption over the course of construction.
