

# MID-HURON LANDFILL SITE BOARD

As you are aware, the Mid-Huron Landfill Site in Holmesville closes as a landfill June 30, 2018. Following closure, the Mid-Huron Landfill Site is to be a recycling depot for those municipalities that wish to participate pursuant to agreement. Currently, the Municipality of Central Huron, the Municipality of Huron East and the Town of Goderich are discussing the use of the site for this purpose. In addition, the Mid-Huron site will continue to be a hazardous waste depot for all municipalities in the County of Huron.

The site will receive the following materials from participating Municipalities materials at the recycling depot after June 30, 2018:

- Shingles
- Wood
- Steel
- Tires
- E-waste

The conditions at this time applicable to the recycling depot would be as follows:

- Carriers collecting curbside refuse cannot bring refuse to the site
- Any mixed loads received must be sorted and unloaded manually by the Contractor or individual
- Hazardous waste will be accepted from all Huron County municipalities
- Other conditions will be forthcoming as determined by a Board


The Mid-Huron Landfill Site Board currently has six municipalities (the Municipality of Central Huron, the Municipality of Huron East, the Town of Goderich, the Township of Huron-Kinloss, Municipality of Bluewater and the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh) pursuant to the current agreement. The existing Landfill Site Board and the municipalities under the agreement are responsible for the operation and monitoring of the existing site after closure for the next 50 years, including leachate removal and other requirements as determined by the Board's Consultant GHD and required by the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change. There will be another Board possibly formed consisting of at least the three municipalities noted above for the purposes of a recycling depot.

A detailed budget will be developed by the Treasurer of Goderich for consideration of the Board and further those municipalities that will participate under a separate budget for the recycling

depot. There have been previous PowerPoint presentations to the existing board and to the Landfill 3 that also have provided information concerning the future of the site.

There will be a public meeting/open house held on February 1, 2018 at 4:30 p.m. in the Town of Goderich Council Chambers, 57 West Street, concerning the closure of the Mid-Huron Landfill Site and the future options for a recycling depot.
