

Corporation of the Village of Bayfield

BEING a By-law prohibiting the depositing of snow on street allowances within the Village of Bayfield.

WHEREAS the municipality has the authority, pursuant to Section 315(1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980 Chapter 302 and amendments thereto, the depositing of snow on any highway or bridge within the municipality.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Bayfield ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;

1. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow or ice upon any portion of any highway, street, or bridge located within the territorial limits of the Corporation of the Village of Bayfield.
2. No person shall move snow within the street allowance from one side of the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic to the other side of the street allowance.
3. No person shall relocate snow within the street allowance in such a manner as to encroach on the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular or pedestrian traffic, or that would result in the obstruction of the normal visibility for safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the street allowance.
4. This by-law shall apply to the whole of the Corporation of the Village of Bayfield.
5. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law shall, upon conviction therefor, forfeit and pay a fine not exceeding \$300.00 on each conviction and the penalty and costs shall be recoverable under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act, being Chapter 400, of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1980.

Read a second time this 30<sup>th</sup> day of February 1984.

Read a third time and finally passed this 30<sup>th</sup> day of February 1984.
