## The Corporation of the Municipality of Bluewater

## **By-Law Number 100-2023**

Being a By-law to amend By-law 148-2022, as amended, to provide for various Fees and Charges

Whereas section 391 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2003, S.O., c. 25 as amended (Municipal Act) provides that without limiting sections 9, 10 and 11, those sections authorize a municipality to impose fees or charges on persons,

- a) For services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;
- b) For costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board;
- c) For the use of its property including property under its control; and

Whereas under section 391 (4) of the Municipal Act a fee or charge may be imposed whether or not it is mandatory for the municipality or local board imposing the fee or charge to provide or do the service or activity, pay the costs or allow the use of its property; and,

Whereas the Council of the Municipality of Bluewater deems it expedient to amend By-law-148-2022, being a By-law to provide for various fees and charges, to add a short-term rental licensing fee refund structure; and

**Now therefore** The Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Bluewater enacts as follows:

THAT Schedule "A" of By-law 148-2022 be amended by inserting the following:
