

Corporation of the Village of Bayfield

By-law 419- 1989

The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Section 315.4, Chapter 302, Parts 5 and 6 prohibits the throwing, placing or depositing of dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper or other rubbish or refuse, or the carcass of any animal, on any highway or bridge and prohibits the obstruction of ditches or culverts upon highways.

The Municipal Act. R.S.O. 1980, Section 321, Chap.302 provides for the imposing of fines by Councils;

The Council of the Corporation of the Village of Bayfield deems it adviseable to pass such a by-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Bayfield enacts as follows;

This by-law prohibits the throwing, placing or depositing of dirt, filth, glass, handbills, paper or other rubbish or refuse, or the carcass of any animal on any highway or bridge and prohibits the obstruction of ditches or culverts upon highways within the Village of Bayfield.



Any person either manually or by mechanical means that contravenes this by-law shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 dollars exclusive of costs.

Each contravention shall be considered a separate offence for the purpose of this by-law.

Should any provision of this by-law be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or ultra vires for any reason, the remaining provisions shall, nevertheless, remain valid and binding and shall be read as if the offending section had been struck out.

This by-law shall come into effect on its passing.

Read a first time this 5th day of June 1989.  
Read a second time this 5th day of June 1989.  
Read a third time and finally passed this 5th day of June 1989.
